Rules and Expectations

Indian Hills High School was established as an alternative for students who could be successful in a smaller educational environment. The following rules and expectations are designed to assist you in navigating the standards of behavior that are required by our school and the Las Virgenes Unified School District.

1. All students are to be at school everyday and on time. If there is a legitimate reason for missing school, parents are asked to call the day of the absence. The school will call on every absence. Students leaving campus for any reason and not checking out through the office will be considered truant. If there is no reason for the absence, the administration will work with the Lost Hills Sheriff's Department by issuing a Truancy Ticket that carries a fine. Truancy is illegal in the State of California.
2. Smoking and use of tobacco products, and possession of lighters anywhere on campus is strictly prohibited. Students who violate this policy are subject to suspension and will be ticketed by law enforcement.
3. The following major violations will automatically carry between a three and five day suspension and will be subject to referral to the law enforcement

Violence/Bullying/Sexual Harassment: Any student who engages in any form of physical or verbal violence will be subject to suspension and a review for a recommendation for expulsion. This is a "zero" tolerance policy.

Illegal Substances/Illegal Use of Prescription Drugs: Students using, under the influence, or possessing any illegal substance will automatically be suspended, referred to law enforcement, and be recommended for expulsion from the Las Virgenes Unified School District.

Students are expected to refrain from any use of profanity. Any form of aggressive behavior toward a teacher or faculty member will not be tolerated and, depending on the seriousness of the offense will be suspended or recommended for expulsion.

4. Appropriate dress is required at all times. The LVUSD Dress Code is enforced at Indian Hills High School.
5. The use of cell phones is not permitted while on the Indian Hills Campus. Use of cell phones will result in their being confiscated on the first offense. On the second offense, parents will be required to come to campus to pick them up for their child.
6. There is an assigned area for student parking. Only cars with an approved permit may park in the student lot. Students parking illegally will be ticketed and their cars towed. No student may go to their car without being accompanied by a faculty member.
